SPECIAL ELECTION FOR RENEWAL AND CONTINUATION OF LEVY OF THE 3.5 MILL COUNTYWIDE SCHOOL TAX

(Section 269.01, Constitution of Alabama of 2022)

Shall the governing body of Montgomery County, Alabama, be authorized to levy annually, for a period of thirty (30) successive years, commencing with the levy for the tax year that will begin on October 1, 2024 (for which tax year taxes will become due and payable on October 1, 2025), for public school purposes in said county, a special property tax at the rate of thirty-five cents on property tax at the rate of thirty-five cents on each one hundred dollars (equal to 3.5 mills on each dollar) of the assessed value of the taxable property in said county, which special tax shall be in renewal and continuation of the special tax at the same rate and for the same purpose that is now being levied in the said county?

THIS OFFICE **RUNS BY** DISTRICT

The Alabama Democratic Conference (ADC) is not endorsing delegates for the Democratic National Convention. The candidates have no opposition and, therefore, need no endorsement. They were appointed "by Hands Unknown." Eighty-one (81) of Alabama delegates pledged to Joe Biden and Kamala Harris were removed from the ballot, no reason given. Of the 849,624 democrats in Alabama who are being denied their right to vote for the district delegates, 562,000 are black (66%). The ADC is fighting this illegal and shameful plot.
